How we spent last year’s allocation

No school received Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium in 2020-21.

The last funding was received in 2019-20 and the evaluation report can be found on our website.

To support literacy in the school we purchased MyOn digital online software to support the teaching of Reading.

How our approach has made a difference to the attainment of the pupils arriving below national expectations

Reading ages for Year 7 improved by 3 years and 2 months last academic year - an average of 1.06 years per student.

Students have engaged positively with our online reading programme; MyOn. They have read 63 books, 1.1k pages in 588 minutes. By adapting to a digital reading approach, barriers that traditionally inhibited students have been removed to create an enjoyable, engaging and relevant reading experience. MyOn Fosters an enjoyment in reading; providing a gateway to access opportunities across the curriculum.
