How we spent the 2019/2020 allocation

At Hamilton School the Catch Up funding went towards one to one literacy intervention and the development of book club. An online intervention program was also purchased to ensure that progress was monitored and necessary tailored intervention was provided. A literacy and numeracy whole school approach was also adopted and part of the funding went towards developing these skills across the curriculum. As part of the whole school approach staff are informed of reading literacy and numeracy ages to adapt their lessons accordingly. The key focus was to ensure that our students make expected progress across the curriculum. Additional books and equipment were also provided.
