Following our communication earlier this week regarding the forecast extreme temperatures, I would like to provide an update on the arrangements for the remainder of the week.

We have continued to review the latest weather forecasts, alongside our daily heat risk assessments and the measures available to keep students and staff safe whilst in school.


The updated forecast indicates that temperatures on Friday will remain high at 33°C. As a result, we will open the school on Friday, with pupils attending during the morning. However, in order to minimise the risks associated with the hottest part of the day, we will close at 1pm. This includes all alternative provision and tutoring sessions.

These decisions have been made following careful consideration of the forecast conditions, the likely temperatures within the school building during the afternoon, and our responsibility to safeguard the health, safety and wellbeing of students and staff. We recognise that these arrangements may cause inconvenience for some families and would like to thank you for your understanding and support.

We will continue to monitor forecasts and conditions closely and will communicate promptly with families should any further changes to our arrangements become necessary.
