Your child should arrive in plenty of time for their exam. A cooked breakfast will be provided by school at 845am.

These exams are a vital opportunity for students to demonstrate their accumulative knowledge and understanding of topics in preparation for their final GCSEs. It is imperative that students take these exams as seriously as they would their real examinations. Should the school be asked to provide Centre Grades for students, these exams will provide part of the evidence-based grades awarded to students.

Students will be expected to follow all rules and expectations put in place for the running of examinations. Failure to do so could result in the student being seen as committing a malpractice offense.

Each exam will last one hour and students will be provided with all stationery required to complete the paper.

To support students in their preparation for these exams they have been completing sessions within Tutor Time on the dos and don'ts of sitting formal examinations. We would like to encourage you to reiterate this at home with your child.
